<b>10Apr18</b>	<b>Worthing Archaeological Society</b>	<b><u>Dr Jaime Kaminski: The science of a Middle Bronze Age hoard</u></b> In March 2011 a spectacular Middle Bronze Age hoard was discovered by a metal detectorist on land belonging to the Glynde Estate 'Near Lewes', East Sussex. Comprising nearly eighty artefacts and artefact fragments the hoard has recently been subject to scientific analysis. This presentation will consider what the analyses tell us about the production of the artefacts in the hoard and the implications for Bronze Age craft production.
